

over the trail network that runs through the Longleaf at Oakland neighborhood connecting the three cemeteries in town and will also connect to the West Orange Trail. Due to these additions, the town needs to adopt a set of guidelines and rules that can be used for the trails. The trail rules are meant to be enforceable by the Oakland Police Department and the guidelines are best practices and are consistent with the Orange County Parks and Recreation Division. The rules and guidelines will be used for publication on the Town's website and on future signs along the trail. There was some discussion about skateboards as skateboarders have been going up down the ramps at the Heritage Center. Skateboards are allowed on the trails however we need to add signage on the facility ramp regarding no skateboarding. Per Town Attorney Vose, we should get signs up as soon as possible. Town Manager Koontz says we are working on a sign package for the Healthy West Orange Arts and Heritage Center however since we need to address this issue right away, we will get temporary signs put up until we can get the more permanent ones in place.
