Garbage – Recycling – Yard Waste

Tips for Problem-Free Collection Service

- Place material out after 6:00p.m. the night before or by 6:00a.m. the day of collection to be sure you do not miss the collection truck.
- Place material within 3 feet of the curb.
- Remove containers from the curb within 12 hours after pickup.
- DO NOT MIX yard waste, garbage, and recyclables.
- Containers, bundles, and bins must weigh less than 50 pounds when full.
- Container capacity must not exceed 50 gallons.
- Material not set out properly will be tagged.

Garbage – Collected Tuesday and Friday

- Garbage collection is for household waste. DO NOT mix recyclables, hazardous waste, or yard waste with your garbage.
- Large items such as furniture, appliances, mattresses, and up to 4 automobile tires or pickup truck tires are collected on your second household garbage collection day. Automobile parts; hazardous waste; and freon-containing devices, such as freezers and refrigerators, **are not included in your curbside collection program.**



Recycling – Collected Friday

- In recycle bin, place newspapers, pasteboard (e.g., cereal boxes, empty paper towel and toilet paper rolls, and shoe boxes), brown paper bags, flattened corrugated cardboard boxes, phone books, magazines, catalogs, junk mail (unopened or opened envelopes), and office paper (does not include shredded paper). Flattened cardboard may be placed next to the recycling bin and should be no larger than 3 feet by 3 feet.
- Also place aluminum and tin cans, glass bottles and jars, drink boxes and milk/juice cartons, empty aerosol cans, plastic containers with a #1 or #2 symbol on the bottom, and plastic bottles with a neck and #3 or #7 symbol on the bottom.
- Do not use plastic bags for recycling. If your recycling bin is full, put the excess recyclables into brown paper grocery bags or cardboard boxes no larger than the size of a recycling bin. Excess newspapers and magazines may be stacked and tied with string.



Yard Waste – Collected Wednesday

- Yard waste collection is for all vegetative landscaping material, grass, and **tree and shrub trimmings.**
- Removal of wood debris generated as a result of tree removals, whether by homeowner or a contractor, is not included in yard waste service.
- Please bundle tree and shrub clippings into lengths of 5 feet or less, or place into a container that can be lifted. Each bundle, container, or item must weigh less than 50 pounds. While it is not necessary to tie the bundles with string or twine, it is very much appreciated as it makes the bundle much easier for our employees to lift up and into the truck.
