## TOWN APPROVES TRAIL RULES AND GUIDELINES

The West Orange Trail has been a part of the fabric of the Town of Oakland for many years but was previously under the jurisdiction of Orange County. The Town has built the Healthy West Orange Arts and Heritage Center adjacent to the trail, and with that project has taken over two blocks of the West Orange Trail. This was done to bring together the landscaping, the signage, the building, the furnishings, the maintenance, and the trail into one cohesive experience.

The Town will also be taking over the trail network that will connect to the West Orange Trail and runs through the Longleaf at Oakland neighborhood, connecting the three cemeteries in Town.

The trail rules are meant to be enforceable by the Oakland Police Department and the guidelines are best practices and are consistent with Orange County Parks and Recreation Division.
